



### USING VETERAN PLAQUE & FAMILY PURCHASED MEMORIALS

Choose the 5"x8" bronze. We can install the 5"x8" on granite at no charge at the end of most sizes of bronze family memorials. The 24"x12" will not fit and can not be used with any other marker on the grave. We no longer offset veteran markers. They always go directly to the side of the family marker.

### IF YOU PLAN TO BUY A FAMILY MARKER LATER

Choose the 5"x8" bronze veteran plaque. The cemetery can install the 5"x8" bronze in carnelian granite at no charge.

If the family later chooses a bronze family marker, the cemetery can move the 5"x8" bronze on granite to the end of the new marker at no charge.

The 24"x12" bronze can be installed on concrete at no charge in the Garden areas, However, its large size makes it necessary to remove it if another marker is purchased later. Government markers will **not** be left on the ground and offset as they had been in the past.

For now, those that were installed with a family marker before Jan. 1, 1996 may remain.

### USING ONLY THE VETERAN MARKER

The 24"x12" bronze marker can be installed on granite with no vase, a granite vase or a bronze vase. There is a charge for the granite and vase.

The 24"x12" bronze marker can be installed as a companion with no vase, a bronze vase or a granite vase. There is a separate bronze plaque for the spouse. There is a charge for the granite, bronze and vase. Separate bronze emblems may be ordered to glue into granite.



### OPTIONS AT NO CHARGE

We can install a 24"x12" bronze marker on concrete with a concrete extension for a flowerpot at no charge.

We can install the 5"x8" bronze marker on 10"x10" granite at no charge. There is no provision for flowers.

## PLANNING THE DISPLAY OF YOUR VETERAN'S MEMORIAL

In January 2002, the Federal Government changed its policy to allow cemeteries to install Government markers on "marked" and "unmarked" graves of veterans. This change was made permanent in January of 2008. Garland Brook has modified its Rules and Regulations to allow us to install both the government and family markers on the same grave.

This change in policy makes it possible for every veteran buried in Garland Brook to use a Veteran Memorial. However, it does not provide for every type of marker to be installed in every way in every section.

The purpose of this pamphlet is to allow families to see the possibilities and make the choice that is right for their veteran. There are many options available. We can install many of them at no charge to the family.

We will be happy to help you plan how best to display the government marker. Please call us if you have a question.

### ORDERING

In Columbus, the forms to apply for veteran government markers are available at local funeral homes, and the Veterans Service Office, 440 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, (379-1540).

The cemetery reviews each application, signs that we will accept the type of marker requested, and keeps the family's installation plans on file. Delivery time is usually 3-4 months.

We appreciate talking with each family so that we know how the family would like the marker to be displayed. Any of us will gladly help your family choose the type of marker and type of installation that best serve your needs.
